Consultant Colorectal Surgeon Hugh Paterson

After graduating from University of Aberdeen Medical School, Hugh undertook basic surgical training in the West of Scotland before heading to Boston, USA for 2 years of research into injury-induced host immune responses at Brigham and Women's Hospital/Harvard Medical School, completing a MD. He returned to complete higher surgical training in South-east Scotland followed by a post-CCT fellowship in laparoscopic colorectal surgery at Université catholique de Louvain, Brussels.

Hugh returned to Western General Hospital as a Clinical Senior Lecturer in 2008.

Hugh's research interest is clinical trials in

perioperative care, and developing local clinical colorectal surgical research. We asked him how he has sought to develop this at WGH:

"I started with a feasibility RCT at WGH of Targinact®, an analgesic combining oxycodone and oral naloxone, ostensibly to see if it might ameliorate opioidinduced GI side-effects to hasten return of GI function after colectomy, but mainly to evaluate recovery event rates and end-points. At around the same time I took the University of Edinburgh online PG Cert in Clinical Trials. With encouragement and input from the late Ken Fearon I submitted a successful funding application to NIHR-HTA for a £1.3 million UK multicentre RCT of perioperative IV lidocaine in minimally invasive colorectal surgery (ALLEGRO), currently in progress. Hugh's other goal is to develop the clinical trial infrastructure in the colorectal unit at WGH. NHS Lothian R&D has supported this with a full time Clinical Research Nurse, Marion MacRury, and the ALLEGRO clinical trial manager, Angie Balfour, who are both based in the unit. These roles have been crucial to a huge expansion in local recruitment to a variety of national colorectal clinical trials and studies (CREST-2, Prepare-ABC, PITSTOP, CIPHER, ROSSINI-2). With a view to sustainability of funding, we have also harnessed the high unit throughput to complete commercially sponsored post-marketing surveillance device trials. News from the Colorectal Group at the WGH

The Annual Meeting of Association of Coloproctology in Great Britain and Ireland was due to be held in Edinburgh this year, but due to the pandemic was moved online as the 'Virtual Edinburgh Fringe' (5th-8th July). It was well represented by the unit, with Mr Peter Vaughan-Shaw, Miss Farhat Din and Miss Yasuko Maeda

all chairing sessions and giving talks. Peter has become the President of Duke's Club which is a trainees' group within ACPGBI. Congratulations, Peter! We had 2 oral presentations and 11 poster presentations at the meeting.

In July, we also launched a new Twitter account as the Colorectal Research group. Please check out @EdinburghColo. Mr Adam Gerrard has started as a clinical research fellow in August and he will work towards his PhD based on projects using quantitative faecal immunochemical testing (qFIT).

At the end of September, the Annual Meeting of European Society of Coloproctology was also held virtually. The unit presented 11 abstracts in total. Mr Mark Potter, Mr Doug Speake and Miss Yasuko Maeda were busy chairing and giving lectures on faecal incontinence and robotic surgery.

We are active and busy in both translational and clinical research, resulting in 20 publications in the last 5 months.

Following a pause due to Covid19, the team at WGH are working to restart recruitment for the following trials:

ALLEGRO: a placebo controlled randomised trial of intravenous lidocaine in accelerating gastrointestinal recovery after colorectal surgery.

PITTSTOP: pilonidal sinus treatment: studying the options:

CIPHER: UK cohort study to investigate the prevention of parastomal hernia

CREST2: Uncovered vs covered endoluminal stenting in the acute management of obstructing colorectal cancer in the palliative setting.

PREPARE ABC: SupPoRtive Exercise Programmes for Accelerating REcovery after major ABdominal Cancer surgery - this trial
